Provide: Boat make, model and name; PHRF rating (if unknown, one will be provided).

Start: Between the RC flying the RRBC Burgee at G "1" (Fl G 4s) off of the West River (CBYRA Region 3 mark "Z").

Finish: Between the RC flying the CBPSA Burgee and Harris Creek Fl R 2.5s 18ft. "2-H". If no RC boat is present the first yacht finishing is asked to drop an anchor and establish a line for subsequent boats finishing.

Course: Choptank "G-7" (Fl G 4s Bell) to Choptank "R-10" (Fl R 2.5s Bell). Leave both marks to port.

Signals: The "really old fashioned" way of starting: (this changes RRS 26)

We will try to give each PHRF rating a start signal by radio on Channel 69, but your assigned start time will govern in the event of an omission or error.

Time Limit: If the first boat to round G-7 does so after 1600, that boat should anchor there and finish subsequent boats UNLESS the RC has already moved to that location.

Protests: A boat intending to protest shall inform the race committee as soon as possible after finishing, and shall include the sail number or boat name of the protested yacht. If protests *must* be made, then we have an obligation to listen to them, decide the appropriate action and then go party. The loser of the protest buys.

Awards: Awards will be presented at the raft up in Dun Cove. If you're not there, you don't get it!

Other: VHF Channel 69 will be monitored. Yachts retiring from the race are requested to notify the race committee by hail, VHF or cell phone (call someone!).

Raft-up: After finishing, proceed to Dun Cove for the raft-up. Please remember if you are rafting up to another boat, be ready with your own lines and fenders. If you are an anchor boat, please pick a spot that is well protected and that can accommodate a number of boats. Also, if you need to leave early, please tie up on the outside of the raft. Please bring extra food and drinks to share with others.

Results: Will be posted on PSA web site (<http://www.cbpsa.org>) and RRBC web site (<http://www.rhoderiverbc.org>) and will be e-mailed upon request.

Pre-Race:

Friday night before the Dun Cove race Eleanor Holmes and Phil Rost aboard the RC boat Buloha will be at the West River Sailing Club. The club has a pier which accommodates boats that draw up to about 7 feet, and several mooring balls.
